Documents to file for a Temporary Restraining Order and/or Injunction.

In order to fill out the initial paperwork, you will want to gather the following information:

- Details of the abuse (dates, times, locations, specific incidents)
- Information about the abuser (name, address, date of birth, physical description)

Petition for Temporary Restraining Order and/or Petition and Motion for Injunction Hearing (Domestic Abuse)

Initiate domestic abuse TRO or Injunction. Available in Spanish and Hmong.

Confidential Address Information in Domestic Abuse, Child Abuse, Individual at Risk, and Harassment Temporary Restraining Order and Injunction Actions

To provide confidentiality of the petitioners address in Domestic Abuse, Child Abuse, Individual at Risk, and Harassment TRO/Injunction actions.

Temporary Restraining Order and Notice of Injunction Hearing (Domestic Abuse)

Formal order concerning petition for TRO and scheduling the matter for a hearing on the final injunction. Available in Spanish and Hmong.

Notice and Order for Injunction Hearing When Temporary Restraining Order is Not Issued (Domestic Abuse)
