To get legal services, you will need to provide:

- Proof of HIV status
- Proof of residency
- Proof of income or zero income

[Request a Consultation](#)**Other Eligibility**

- For all legal services, must be **HIV positive & above 18 years old**.
- No income limit for brief legal advice.
- Must be below **500%** of the Federal Poverty Level for **Confidentiality/privacy** representation, **Discrimination** representation, and assistance with **Estate Planning & Advance Directives**.
- Must be below **125%** of the Federal Poverty Level for **Housing** representation & **Social Security** representation.
