The service is provided on a first come, first served basis. Due to increased volume, it is possible that if you may not be seen if you do not come early. What to Bring:

- List of all property/possessions and their resale values;
- List of all debts (creditor name and address, account number and amount due);
- Payroll advices and documentation of all other sources of income for prior six months;
- Current mortgage and auto loan statements;
- All lawsuit papers;
- All loan contracts or leases;
- Two prior years' tax returns;
- Three months of bank statements and a budget.
